## **Conifer Wireless Announces Completion of Phase One Wireless Network In Kosova.**

Scottsdale, AZ. . . . January 19, 2004 . . . Conifer Wireless announces today that it has completed the design, construction and implementation of Phase One of a wireless network for IPKOnet, LLC to enable IP based services throughout Kosova. This project uses equipment and SkyPath software supplied by Conifer Wireless and its sister company EMCEE Communications, to provide IP based services to 75% of the populated areas throughout Kosova. IPKOnet, the largest Internet Service Provider in Kosova, provides mission critical services on this new wireless network to mostly businesses and government institutions including Banks and Bank ATM's, Customs Offices, Health and Medical facilities, emergency services, and other businesses of all types and sizes.

Larry Mack, President of Conifer Wireless comments, "Our design and construction of five wireless access hubs connected to the IPKOnet microwave backbone built for this project and to their new Network Operations Center in Prishtina was far less time consuming, and at a fraction of the cost of a comparable fiber network. IPKOnet was able to serve their first customer on the new network only 8 months after we joined forces with IPKOnet to design the entire network. For a region with very little communication infrastructure, this has become a major economic development factor."

Bujar Musa, President of IPKOnet says, "The best our customers outside of Prishtina could get was very expensive dialup Internet Access services due to the high usage costs charged by the local telephone operator. There was no inter-city data transport network. Our new wireless network provides our customers a cost effective alternative to the telephone company for broadband service that was previously unavailable at any price."

Now that IPKOnet has proven that it can maintain and manage a sophisticated network with many satisfied customers, Conifer Wireless and IPKOnet are planning to extend the network in the Spring of 2004 to critical areas where the wireless service is not yet available.
